Embracing colour

Colour can be used to achieve more than just reflecting corporate identity, playing a significant role in defining the space.

While it is common practice to use colour to reflect brand and identity within commercial interiors, it can play a far more instrumental role in how users interact with their space.

The floor becomes an integral component in developing a positive emotional response to the space, yet it must achieve this within the confines of practical expectation. Not only diverse in available colours, the floor must also provide universal performance throughout the palette.

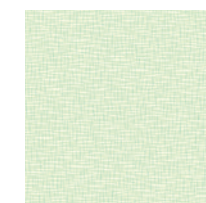

Colours in the right solution

By combining the two factors, it not only becomes possible to define the principle activity, but also harness physical benefits.

Improved acoustics

Unwanted sound is a factor that is commonly attributed to a user's enjoyment and perception of the space, as well as a known factor in detracting from productivity.
With IVC's **Optimise 70** collection, you can reduce impact noise by 19dB while using its 24 colours to create an interior that forsters positive mental wellbeing.

Reduced accidents

Minimising the risk of accidents is of central importance in many projects, but particularly aged care and healthcare environments. There's also good reason to use the positive effects of colour in these spaces.

With IVC's **Isafe 70** safety flooring collection, projects can enjoy a PTV of 40, enough to provide low potential for slip. And in 14 colours, as well as wood and material effects, the Isafe collection provides sufficient choice for improving wellbeing.

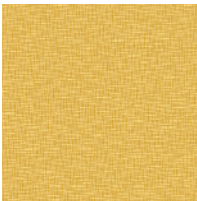
Heavy duty

The need to zone and create activity areas within open plan spaces without compromising a floor's ability to cope with heavy duty wear makes **Concept 70** the ideal choice.

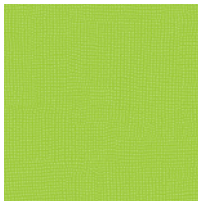

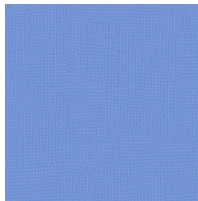

The successful zoning of an open space using Concept 70 Harlem T71 can encourage contemplation. By opting for subdued, greyed-off tones the effect remains distinct without become too overbearing for infants.

Zoning through colour

With the wide choice across IVC's Heterogeneous Vinyl, zoning through colour is easy, even if the project requires a specialised solution such as acoustic or safety flooring.

By using combinations that support the activity of the area, zoning can be achieved in a manner that fosters wellbeing, while ensuring that practical needs such as acoustics and low maintenance are met.

Take the Optimise 70 acoustic flooring collection as an example. Capable of reducing impact noise by 19dB, the floor makes an excellent choice for areas where wellbeing centres on providing an environment that encourages productivity.

Available in 26 colours, as well as wood and material effects, it can be used to create clear zones in colours that support the intended activity of that space. For example, creative areas may benefit from the confidence-inspiring yellow of Harlem T55, while quiet contemplation areas from the green of Harlem T71.

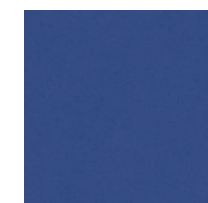

Colour zoning for the future

There is no doubt that future projects will need to embrace safe distancing within layouts, but they will need to do so without compromising the aesthetic principles of the interior. As a universal language that everyone speaks and understands, colour can be a good way to overcome this challenge.

With Heterogeneous Vinyl from IVC, projects can fulfil both these needs while also providing a surface that is easy to maintain and in some solutions, protected with Sanitec anti-microbial treatment.

By ensuring zones or an alternating colour layout at a minimum radius or width of 1.5m (2m in the UK), the floor can go from a design based around sound colour and wellbeing principles to one that can be immediately turned to mark safe distances when necessary.

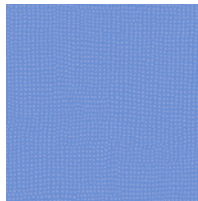

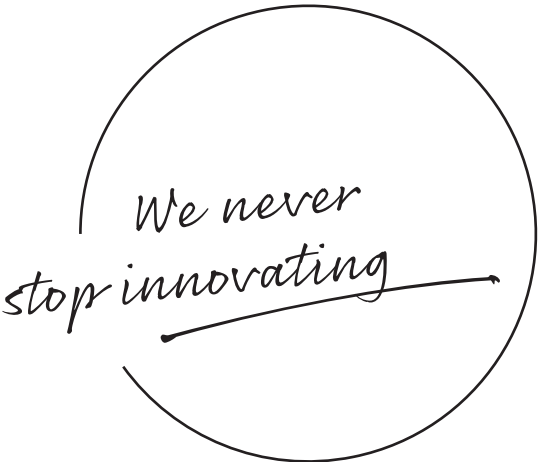

Using colour as a way to outline zones can also play a dual-role in making safe distance measures more obvious to users. With a minimum gap of 1.5m, this entrance lobby design using colours in Harlem from Concept 70 can double as a marker of safe distances between users.

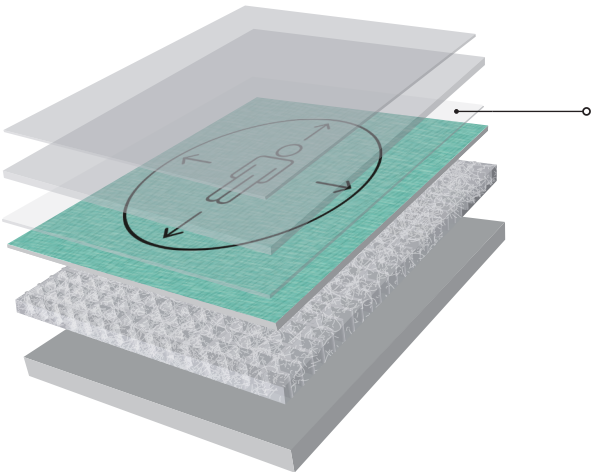

Set at intervals of 1.5m, it is an ideal solution for a range of environments. Fully protected by our hardwearing wear layer and Hyperguard+ PUR treatment, overprint lasts for the lifetime of the floor.

Invisiweld
Invisiweld is our bond technology for the visually seamless installation of Heterogeneous Vinyl floors.

Leaving an invisible join between areas, Invisiweld is suitable for creating zones without compromising the integrity of the design, making it ideal for colour and material effects. As well as its aesthetic benefits, Invisiweld leaves a stronger joint that's less prone to failure and gives nowhere for dirt to build-up.

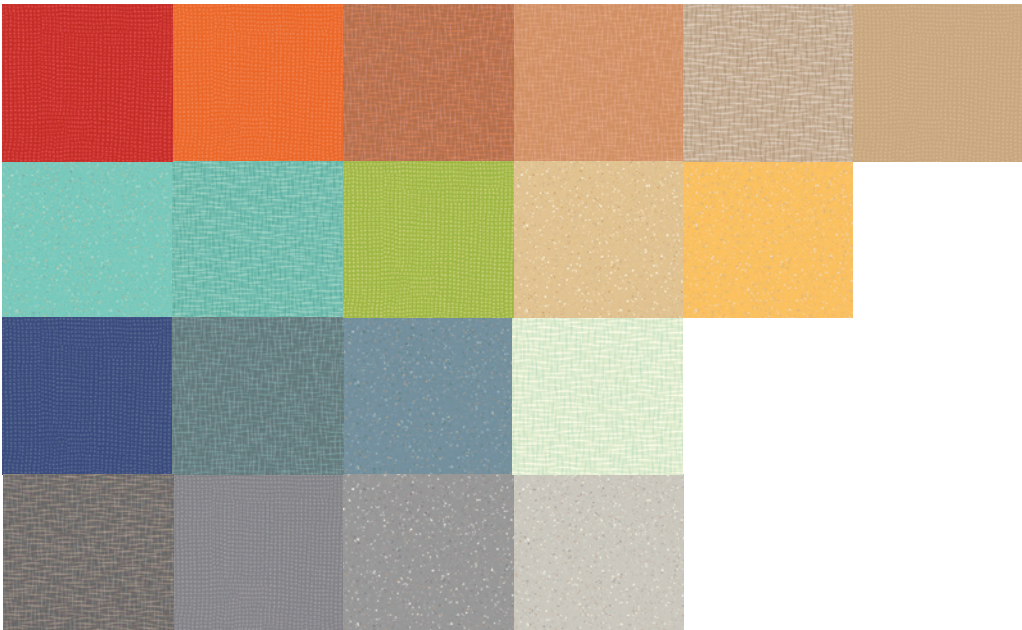

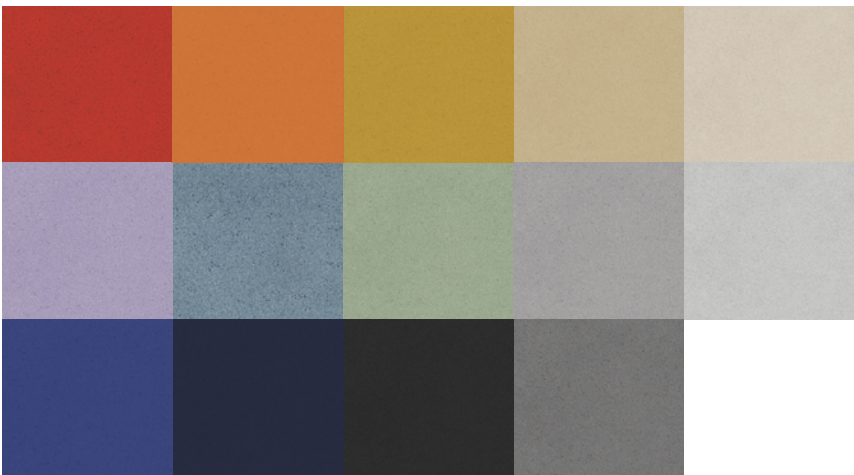
